For YWAM Juba, South Sudan, the unrest has meant they have not been able to run their Discipleship Training School (DTS), but they hope to begin again with a DTS in July of this year. They continue evangelism, mercy ministry, working with children, women's ministry, and showing the Jesus Film. Recently they shared the gospel at a camp for displaced persons.
